

Sunday Worship in Braswell Hall

Greetings! We hope all are staying cool from this heat. Speaking of, we are pleased to announce that our Sunday worship service will be inside Braswell Hall, starting Sunday, July 19th at 10:30am. A few specifics:

- Your health and safety has been the number one priority as your staff and deacon team have planned indoor services. That will continue to be our highest priority throughout this public health emergency.
- Parking lot attendants will be present when you arrive. They will be able to guide you with the process below.
- 3 entrances will be used to Braswell Hall to assure your safety and physical distancing. Please plan to park closest to your designated entrance. See the image below.
 - Senior citizens – 65 years or older – 1 or 2 in a group – park at the kitchen entrance near Braswell Hall. This will be the **Orange** section. Seating will be indicated by **Orange** tape on the floor.
 - Families with 3 or more – regardless of age – park in the area closest to the East Foyer entrance. This will be the **Red** section. This seating area will be designated with **Red** tape on the floor. *(A goodie bag will be available for small children at this entrance.)*
 - All others – individuals, or groups, that do not meet the above criteria. These individuals should park near the entrance closest to the sanctuary. This entrance and seating area will be **Blue** and will be noted with **Blue** tape on the floor.



- Masks will be required to enter Braswell Hall and during worship. Masks will be available at each of the above entrances for those that forgot their personal mask. *(The Governor mandates masks for children 11 or older. Parents can choose if younger children should wear a mask.)*
- Hand sanitizer will also be available at each of the above entrances.

Other helpful information

- To promote a safe and comforting environment we are asking everyone to stay within their designated section.
- The worship service will last approximately 45 minutes.
- For the time being there will be no nursery or children's church. Children should remain with their parents.
- Each section will also have its own designated restrooms. Any usher should be able to guide you if needed.
- Also, to be safe and comforting to others, there will not be any congregational singing.
- Please leave out of the same door that you entered.
- Boxes for your tithes and offerings will be at each exit.
